Academic Program

Cornerstone Christian School is a kindergarten through 12th grade college preparatory school. The curriculum is comprised of a variety of leading publishers which provides students with a comprehensive scope and sequence from the first day of kindergarten to the last day in high school. Our early elementary grades focus on phonics as a key element in learning to read well.

Thematic units that emphasize hands-on activities are important components in our curriculum, particularly in our mathematics, science, and history classes. Our curriculum focuses on the development of critical thinking skills and effective communication in the areas of speaking, reading, and writing. Learning to read must be accomplished by understanding what is read

With today's digital technology, CCS is changing the way our teachers teach and our students learn. CCS is bringing more digital learning into the classroom with devices like tablets to enable students to research subjects in real time and offer students broader educational tools. Our high academic achievers can take a variety of AP classes and can be inducted into the National Honor Society.

Most importantly, the CCS curriculum includes Bible classes, chapel time; and our teachers are expected to integrate Scriptural principals throughout their teaching in all other subject matters to enforce the advantage of a Christian worldview.

Performing Arts Program

CCS offers a performing arts program to all CCS students. The mission of the fine arts department of CCS is to give each student the ability to use their God given talents in a way that will give them a strong self-image and an ability to work well with others. Starting with the Performing Arts program in the Elementary classes, and continuing with drama, choir and theater classes through Middle School and High School, the department teaches skills in a variety of areas. Students have the opportunity to share what they have learned in chapels and Christmas and spring school programs.

The entire department is involved in the production of an all-school musical each year. Students from the ages of 5 to the graduating seniors work together to present a show of high quality and value. It is an event that is well attended by our entire community.

Athletic Program

The CCS athletic program is designed to meet the state requirements for physical education as part of the daily curriculum for kindergarten through tenth grades.

Beginning in sixth grade, students are eligible for the middle school teams which participate in league play throughout the school year. Ninth through twelfth grade students are eligible for varsity level sports which participate in CIF's small school league.
