## INTERNATIONAL STUDENT GUIDE 2025-2026

Welcome to International Student Admissions at Cornerstone Christian School (CCS)! Applying to our school as an international student is easy. We are here to assist you with your application and we will do our best to make it a pleasant experience for you. We look forward to meeting each new student.

Please remember that all documents submitted must be in English or accompanied by a certified English translation and should be clearly legible. All documents must be submitted to the CCS International Director/PDSO. School must receive original documents.

### **Knowing the English Language**

International students must have the ability to function in a classroom where instruction is provided only in English.

### **Record of Your Grades or Marks**

Student must have a minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.5 to be considered for enrollment. Record of your grades or marks from elementary, middle school, or high school must be submitted in English or accompanied by a certified English translation.

### **Immunization Record, T-dap and Tuberculosis Test**

A current California School Immunization Record must be submitted with the application. See attached immunization card and requirements. Immunization records **MUST** be translated into English. Student must also submit results from a current T-dap (Whooping Cough) and Tuberculosis test.

### **Tuition and Fees**

All tuition, homestay and fees must be **paid in full upon enrollment**.

### **School Dress Code**

Collared shirts, polo shirts and pants may be purchased at Wal-Mart, Target, JC Penney, or any department store.

Costs will vary from store to store. CCS sells spirit T-shirts.

Student must be dressed in dress code on the first day of school. See attached dress code for details.

## **HOW TO APPLY FOR ADMISSIONS (Only completed applications will be reviewed.)**

### **1) Required Documents for International Admissions**

To be considered for admission into Cornerstone Christian School the following documents are required:

- International Student Application (along with \$450 **non-refundable** application fee)
- Parent Agreement
- Student Profile
- Academic Reference
- Record of your Grades or Marks from previous 3 years
- California School Immunization Record (translated into English)
- T-dap Immunization Record (translated into English)
- International Medical Emergency Card
- Copy of valid Passport with Picture

### **2) An interview must be set up with the International Coordinator via WhatsApp, Viber, Skype, or Facebook.**

**All required documents must be received by the school before application will be reviewed.**

### **3) International Registration Fee of \$1,000.00 (must be paid to receive I-20 and letter of acceptance).**

### **School Acceptance and the I-20**

When the Admissions Office receives all of the required documents your application will be evaluated for admission. If student is admitted into Cornerstone Christian School, the Agent/Guardian will receive an I-20 within two days of submission of application. Make sure the application is submitted as soon as possible.

**Please do not wait until the last minute.**

The Agent/Guardian will be contacted when the I-20 is ready for pick up or the I20 can be mailed DHL.

A letter of acceptance will be emailed to the family of the applicant.



## **Admission Checklist**

All documents must be in English or accompanied by a signed official English translation.  
All documents must be submitted to the CCS International Coordinator / PDSO.

### **ONLY COMPLETED APPLICATIONS WILL BE REVIEWED.**

Use the checklist below to help with the enrollment process.

The first day of school is **Tuesday, August 12, 2025**.  
The student should arrive the weekend prior to this date.

**Students who do not have all tuition and fees paid prior to the first day of school will not be permitted to attend classes.**

### **Once Student Arrives In California**

- Call the International Director immediately to inform that the student has arrived in California.
- Student must provide copy of medical insurance to school and host family.
- All remaining unpaid school fees must be **paid in full** before the student arrives to homestay/school. Bank drafts must be confirmed that it has been received by the bank.  
Bank draft fees are to be paid **BY THE STUDENT**.  
**ALL FEES AND TUITION ARE NON-REFUNDABLE**
- An appointment may be made for the student to meet with the School Principal.
- An appointment will be made for the student to meet with the Academic Advisor.  
A class schedule will be issued and books may be picked up from the library.
- Student must be in dress-code approved attire on first day of school (no exceptions).

### **Agent/Guardian/Host Parent**

- Agent/guardian/host parent must complete an International Medical Emergency Card and any other required documents to complete the student's enrollment process.
- If the student is interested in playing a sport with CCS, please inform the Athletic Director.
- If student does not have a debit/credit card, student should set up bank account with agent or host family upon arrival.
- Student should set up cell phone service or other means of staying in contact with host family/school while on outings, etc.
- Student must provide copy of medical insurance to school and host family.
- Student must complete twenty (20) hours of community service per year in the U.S., host families should help them with transportation and arrangements.
- Student, agent, and host family may be asked to attend an International Student Orientation Meeting.

## DRESS CODE 2025-2026

This uniform dress code is not all-inclusive. Any situation not specifically covered herein will be resolved by the administration in accordance with the general intent and purpose of the code. Any and all attire is up to the discretion of the administration.

### **Dress Code: K – 12th Grades (Modesty is a Must!)**

**FREE DRESS MONDAYS:** T-Shirts, multi colored pants, shorts, leggings (bottoms must be covered at all times), skirts are allowed with shorts or leggings underneath (K-5th only). However, Please follow guideline for items that are not allowed.

### **TUESDAY—FRIDAY**

**Tops:** shirts with sleeves and collars are required: pullover, polo or buttoned down sleeved, collared shirt, camisoles. Spirit shirts and/or school colors T-shirts allowed on Friday only.

**Bottoms:** cargo shorts, walking shorts, capris, or athletic tapered pants are acceptable; all bottoms are to be solid in color and shorts must be mid-thigh or longer. All shorts must be past fingertips in length.

**Jeans are ALLOWED** without holes, tears, patches, frayed holes, or frayed edges

**Leggings or yoga pants** can be worn so long as they are worn with a sleeved collared top or skirt that extends down to mid-thigh (front and back). Bottom must be covered at all times.

#### **⇒K – 5<sup>th</sup> Grade GIRLS:**

Uniform-style jumpers with a sleeved, collared shirt underneath

Solid leggings worn below the knee are **required when wearing a jumper, dress, or skirt**

#### **⇒6<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> Grade GIRLS:**

NO dresses allowed

Skirts may be worn provided you are also wearing solid leggings below the knee

**NO dresses or skirts allowed 6th-12th grade**

Leggings / yoga pants can be worn so long as they are worn with a sleeved collared top covering the bottom or skirt that extends down to mid-thigh (front and back).

### **SPIRIT DAY FRIDAYS: CCS SPIRIT WEAR OR SPIRIT WEAR COLORS WITH SOLID BOTTOMS**

#### **SHOES:**

All elementary students are required to wear closed toe shoes each day

No bedroom slippers for any student K-12

HS/MS Students MUST HAVE CLOSED TOE SHOES FOR PE

#### **HAIR/MAKEUP**

Hair should be clean and not be in your face, must be to the side or cut above your eyes.

Avoid extreme or questionable hairstyles.

No excessive or distracting makeup

#### **JEWELRY & PIERCINGS:**

No lip rings, nose rings, or tongue piercing allowed

**Boys:** Earrings or any type of jewelry worn in a piercing is not allowed

**Girls:** Jewelry in moderation can be worn, no inappropriate wording on bracelets or other jewelry

**ATHLETES & PERFORMING ARTS STUDENTS:**

Athletes may wear prescribed bottoms with sports jersey or team shirt on day of game  
Performing Arts students may wear prescribed bottoms with production shirts one week prior to production and the day of production

**NOT ALLOWED / ALL STUDENTS / ALL TIMES:**

**NO HATS ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING(S)**  
All hooded attire, must be off your head while in the building(s)  
No tank or sleeveless tops

**Boys may not wear nail polish**  
No pajamas or bedroom slippers at any time unless prescribed on a specific themed day  
No chains, choke chains, studs or spikes may be worn

**No sweatpants**  
No part of undergarments should be visible  
No slits or tears in clothing either real or fabricated  
No skulls, cross-bones or offensive wording/pictures

**DRESS CODE VIOLATIONS:**

When the Dress Code is violated, the school office will try to contact a parent or guardian to bring their student a change of clothing. If a parent or guardian cannot be reached, the school office will have the student change into their CCS gym clothes. If a student does not have CCS gym clothes, the student will be supplied with a new set of gym clothes and the student's account will be charged the cost of the new gym clothes. Disciplinary steps as outlined in the minor misconduct section of this handbook apply.
